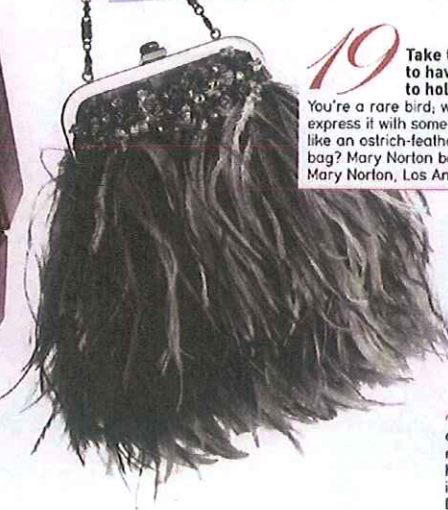
16 Cut (out) the cake
